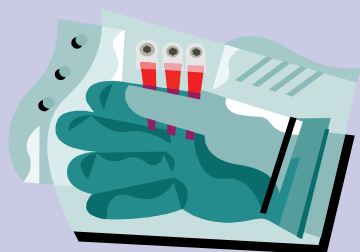


SAT would like to encourage young toxicologists to pursue their interests in and advance the field of toxicology.

STUDENT RESEARCH GRANT



SAT was organized in 1977 for furthering communication among Forensic Toxicologists in the areas of analytical methods and interpretation of findings.

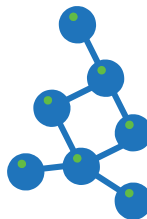
Our members represent laboratories in Texas, Oklahoma, New Mexico, Kansas, Arkansas, Colorado, and Louisiana and service police agencies, medical examiners, racing regulatory agencies, hospitals, drug-free workplaces and academic institutions.

Meetings are held in the spring and fall of each year. Membership is available to those actively involved in the toxicology profession. Communications include meeting proceedings, newsletters published semi-annually, and a group mailing list.



SAT Student Research Grant

The research grant is awarded to students who are working on a research project through an accredited university or laboratory. Recipients of the award, available up to \$1,500.00, must be enrolled in a formal university program in which they are pursuing either an undergraduate or graduate degree in toxicology or related field. Funds are unspecified as to use and can be used for living expenses in conjunction with an internship.



Student Research Grant Requirements

- Applicant must be attending school or work within the SAT membership region
- The recipient must be enrolled in a toxicology program or related degree program
- They must have a relevant project proposed in toxicology



Application Instructions

Applications may be submitted for the Student Research Grant Program up to the June 30th deadline for consideration for funding the following fiscal year (July 1-June 30).

- Go to the SAT website www.sat-tox.org. Click on the Research Tab and Click on the Research Grant Application link to download the complete application. Complete the application in full. Do not submit resumes in the place of an application. Please type or print neatly. Provide your name, address, email contact information and phone numbers where you can be reached throughout the academic year.
- Include a letter of recommendation/endorsement with your application.

Deadline for application is June 30th.

Applications received after June 30th will not be considered for the current fiscal year cycle.

Award notification will be announced in late July.

Individuals selected to receive the SAT Grant will be contacted by the SAT Grant Committee Chair concerning delivery of their grant. The selected students must provide either an address where a check can be sent or all the banking information necessary for the wire transfer of the grant, including the appropriate bank account in the name of the student recipient. The grant funds cannot be sent to a third party or wire transferred to a third party's account.
